### **Golf Courses**

### Titirangi

This is a world-class golf course situated in a beautiful bushland setting between the lower slopes of the Waitakere Ranges and the Manukau Harbour. Founded in 1909, it is a private members club but offers limited playing opportunities for New Zealand and overseas visitors. Titirangi is ranked as one of New Zealand's top courses and is the only one in the country designed by Dr. Alister MacKenzie. After designing Titirangi in 1927, MacKenzie went on to design some of the world's top courses including Augusta, Cypress Point and Royal Melbourne.

### **Gulf Harbour**

This is a great layout to rival any international course. The resort hosted the prestigious World Cup in 1998. Designed by Robert Trent Jones, who likens it to the illustrious Pebble Beach in California, the course played host to the 2005 Holden New Zealand Open where Niclas Fasth of Sweden beat many of the world's top golfers. It also played host to the Blue Chip NZ Open in November 2006. The course is located 35kms north of central Auckland.

### Windross Farm (South Auckland)

Windross Farm is a new, spectacular golf course located only 30 minutes south of the Auckland CBD. It is easily reached from the airport via the motorway. Designed by Brett Thomson, of RBT Design, with course consultant, Phil Titirangi, the course is known for its challenging degrees of interest. The layout is a traditional par 72, with returning 9's of par 36. Both nines are of similar length but play quite differently with varying design elements and the influence of wind direction. Apart from the undulating greens, 38 bunkers and minimal tree presence, the major feature of the course is the water in its many forms with four large lakes interlaced with numerous burns (streams) threading their way in and out of impressive, yet imposing, wetland areas. It is a course that can be challenging or challenged by any level of player on every hole and every shot. The course will play host to the 2017 Ladies New Zealand Open which will be on the LPGA Tour!

### Wainui Golf Club

The 18-hole championship course is set in an iconic New Zealand rural back drop. The course is cut through rolling hills, natural water ways and is framed by 80-year-old statement pines and precise bunkering. This Puddicombe designed course offers golfers of all levels pristine golf surfaces, five tee deck options, varied shot options from the tee with multiple layup areas all on sand capped fairways. Wainui is a world class facility a world away and only 20 minutes from downtown Auckland.

### Muriwai Links Golf Club

To play Muriwai is to play the game of golf as nature intended, The Muriwai Golf Links is a true links course situated amidst the black sand dunes of Auckland's west coast, it offers year-round golf, dry underfoot in the winter & irrigated fairways for great summer conditions. The club offers 18-hole championship golf links along with multiple practice areas: putting green, short game driving range, which includes chipping green & practice bunkers complimented by a full-length driving range. Muriwai is one of the leading links style courses in New Zealand and is home to a number of national events including the recent World Masters Golf tournament, this really is a world class course that always features high in most publications' "top" courses list, it is handily located 45 minutes from downtown Auckland.
