Schedule

Your Mercedes rental vehicle can be delivered the evening prior to the trip or on the first morning. We can provide delivery in Auckland City or at the Airport.

Day 1: Auckland to Hawke's Bay (via Kinloch)

We recommend that you depart Auckland no later than 7:30am Golf at Kinloch. **Tee times: 11:45am onwards** Following golf, the group will travel to Napier and check in to their accommodation. **Evening**: We can make reservations at a local bar / restaurant. **Accommodation**: Quest Apartments, Napier. Studio Apartments x 3 nights

Day 2: Hawke's Bay

Morning: Golf at Hastings GC (Bridge Pa – 25 minutes' drive). Tee times: 10:30am onwards

Day 3: Hawke's Bay Morning: Golf at Cape Kidnappers (45 minutes' drive). Tee times: 10:30am onwards

Day 4: Hawke's Bay to Auckland (via Wairakei) Morning: Depart Napier no later than 8:15am for the 2 hour drive to Taupo. Golf at Wairakei. Tee times: 10:45am onwards Following golf, the group will travel back to Auckland. You can choose to return the vehicle on the evening that you return to Auckland or the following morning.

The Kinloch Club

Cape Kidnappers (Hawke's Bay)

The American designer of Cape Kidnappers, Tom Doak, who is also well known for his prize-winning courses in the US, has said that, 'If Cape Kidnappers were a book it would be an epic. Enjoy your game and enjoy the setting (because) you may never play golf somewhere like this again'. Like Kauri Cliffs, Cape Kidnappers plays above the ocean, atop dramatic cliffs, but unlike Kauri Cliffs, where the shape of the land dictates play along the shoreline, this course runs to and from the edge. Cape Kidnappers is built on a ridge-and-valley landscape with spectacular sea views.

Wairakei Golf and Sanctuary

Wairakei lies on 180 hectares of natural rolling countryside, 6460 metres from championship tees with 108 large well placed bunkers and was developed to meet the rigorous design standards required for world-class championship competitions. Wairakei golf course has been skillfully designed to blend with the surrounding native bush. Prolific birdsong, picturesque scenery and a unique pest-proof sanctuary (the first of its kind) has led to Wairakei being recognised by many as New Zealand's number one golf course. The predator-free sanctuary offers a safe haven to fallow deer and many birdlife including mixed colour pheasants, guinea fowl, ducks, native kiwi and takahe, which are all free to roam around the course.
