Schedule

Your Mercedes rental vehicle can be delivered the evening prior to the trip or on the first morning. We can provide delivery in Auckland City or at the Airport.

Day 1: Auckland to Taupo
We recommend that you depart Auckland no later than 8:30am
Golf at Wairakei. Tee times: 12:30pm onwards
Following golf, the group will check in to your Taupo accommodation.
Accommodation: Voyager Apartments, Taupo. 4 x 2 Bedroom Apartments x 3 nights

Day 2: Taupo

Morning: Golf at Kinloch. Tee times: 10:30am onwards

Day 3: Taupo Morning: Golf at Kinloch. Tee times: 10:30am onwards

Day 4: Taupo to Auckland

Morning: Golf at Wairakei. **Tee times: 9:30am onwards** Following golf, the group will travel back to Auckland. You can choose to return the vehicle on the evening that you return to Auckland or the following morning.

The Golf Courses

Wairakei Golf and Sanctuary

Wairakei lies on 180 hectares of natural rolling countryside, 6460 metres from championship tees with 108 large well placed bunkers and was developed to meet the rigorous design standards required for world-class championship competitions. Wairakei golf course has been skillfully designed to blend with the surrounding native bush. Prolific birdsong, picturesque scenery and a unique pest-proof sanctuary (the first of its kind) has led to Wairakei being recognised by many as New Zealand's number one golf course. The predator-free sanctuary offers a safe haven to fallow deer and many birdlife including mixed colour pheasants, guinea fowl, ducks, native kiwi and takahe, which are all free to roam around the course.

The Kinloch Club

The first Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course to be built in New Zealand has been created around the unique natural features of the site rather than transforming the landscape to meet a uniform golf course design. The course fits the landscape with ease, and the backdrop of Lake Taupo provides a magnificent setting.
