The Golf Courses

Clearwater Resort (Christchurch)

The Clearwater Golf Course has proven itself as a venue for international professional golf over 13 consecutive years, yet it offers a rewarding experience to all visitors from the six tee choices. Walk in the footsteps of Clearwater graduates such as Jason Dufner, Bubba Watson & Jason Day, with its glistening spring-fed lakes, Clearwater lives up to its name, providing a lush oasis close to the city and offers a golfing escape and a change of pace that few destinations can match. A magnificent 18-hole course awaits and is complemented by superb practice areas and impressive accompanying facilities including a fleet of modern electric golf carts equipped with GPS.



Terrace Downs (South of Christchurch)

Terrace Downs is an 18 hole, par 72 championship course that features four different tee positions for the enjoyment of players of all abilities. At a length of 6,406 metres off the back tees, it includes 10 lakes and over 60 bunkers. Terrace Downs golf course has been rated by the New Zealand Golf magazine as one of the top five courses in the country.

Arrowtown GC (Queenstown)

The picturesque Arrowtown Golf Club is set in one of New Zealand's most historic and scenic regions. This golf course is a must when playing golf in Queenstown. Surrounded by mountains, the 18 hole course has superb views from every fairway. Take time to play golf in this inspiring setting, each hole has its own attraction and the diverse and challenging course attracts players from all over the world. Historic stone cottage ruins nestle amongst towering trees. The golf course's link with its gold mining past is highlighted in the names of holes: Sons of Fortune and Golden Arrow, which border the once rich, gold bearing Arrow River.





Millbrook Resort (Queenstown)

Designed by Sir Bob Charles and surrounded by the alpine backdrop of the Remarkables mountain range, the impeccably groomed fairways and greens of Millbrook provide an exhilarating experience. Situated a 20 minute drive from Queenstown the course provides a challenge for golfers of all abilities and is considered to be one of the most impressive international golf arenas in the world. Millbrook has recently added 9 new holes, under the Millbrook West title making 27 holes in total. These holes have boosted Millbrook's reputation as one of New Zealand's best resort courses.

Jacks Point (Queenstown)

With a backdrop of 2300 vertical metres of the Remarkables mountain range and an armchair view of an outstanding lake panoramas, Jack's Point Golf course is one of the most visually spectacular in the world. As an 18 hole par 72 championship course it offers golfers an exciting challenge with five tee positions to choose from, providing all golfers an unforgettable golf experience. The course has been designed around the natural landscape, with minimal excavation. The course is built on the most spectacular of Jack's Point terrain. Designed in harmony with the natural environment, the course weaves through native tussock grasslands, dramatic rock outcrops, steep bluffs and swathes of native bush to the edge of Lake Wakatipu. The presentation of the course is second to none, which makes Jack's Point one of the world's great golfing experiences.

Rendezvous Hotel, Christchurch
